The cover is extended to include a benefit for assault, and forms part of a bigger policy that also covers kidnap, extortion, hijack and detention risks.

"Lloyd's pioneered the kidnap and ransom policy many years ago, so this is a natural development to what was a Lloyd's policy in the first place," says Imogen Lyndon-Skeggs, Underwriter and Director at Griffin, who believes the preventative focus of the product is what separates it from previous attempts to...
